

La Cygne Camp Ground Information

The City of La Cygne welcomes you! Our rustic camping slots include; Electric (30/50amp), Sewer and Water hook-ups, picnic tables, and fire rings or grills. Camping slots are available April-October. You must get a key from the La Cygne City Hall to utilize the showers.

This park is also our community park and therefore several activities take place during the season. There are baseball fields, soccer fields, a swimming pool (open June-Aug), frisbee golf course and an entertainment pavilion. We appreciate your support in following the camping guidelines to ensure that everyone can have an enjoyable time while attending the park.

	Rates are based on (2) Adults and up to (4) Children. \$2.00 additional person/per day
	DAILY CAMPING RATE - \$19/day paid PRIOR to camping – Maximum of (5) Daily Permits purchased consecutively.
	7-Day RV PERMIT - \$126/permit – paid PRIOR to camping – Maximum of (2) permits allowed in a 30-day period.
	14-Day RV PERMIT - \$238/permit – paid PRIOR to camping – Maximum of (1) permit allowed in a 30-day period.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. All campers must make a reservation at La Cygne City Hall **24 hours before your arrival**. In order for utility hook-ups to be unlocked for use. Payment is due at the time of making your reservation.
2. **Check-In times at the La Cygne City Hall are from 1pm-3:30p**, you will receive your camping permit and pick up shower keys if applicable. Campers must display the La Cygne Camping Permit on the utility pole located at your camp site. This enables our local law enforcement to know that you have properly registered with the city.
3. **After hour check-ins** is not allowed, under any circumstance. ALL reservations must be made 24 hours in advance.
4. **Check-out time is 11:00am**, showers key should be dropped off inside La Cygne City Hall or after hours they can be dropped in the depository box located to the right of the La Cygne City Hall entrance.
5. Campers are required to “heat-tape” wrap the water hydrants during times of freezing temps. Campers will be held liable for any costs endured by the park to repair broken water lines.
6. Please put all trash in the dumpster located on the North side of the Camping Area Road.
7. Limited Wi-Fi access is available in the La Cygne Community Park. Extension antennas are located on the shower/bathhouse and the small pavilion north of the large playground. We do not guarantee strong signal or access to the Wi-Fi.
8. (1) Camper **or** (2) tents and (2) vehicles per slot are permissible. (Park additional vehicles in the parking lot located on the north side of the camp road). An additional tent (1 only) may be added for \$10, paid in advance, and must fit on your camping site.
9. In addition to the camper unit, **ONLY** normal basic camping supplies are allowed to be plugged in. (i.e. lights/lanterns, weather radio, fans). The City of La Cygne holds the right to ask for additional items other than the camper unit to be unplugged due to excessive Electrical/Water use (i.e. slip-n-slides, misting units, hot tubs, washing machines/dryers, stand-alone freezer/refrigerators).
10. City Ordinance states it is unlawful for an owner or keeper to allow a dog to run at large at any time. All pets must be on a leash, in a pet kennel or kept in the camper. No more than (2) pets are permissible per camper unit.
11. Campers must respect the “quiet hours” (10pm – 6am) of the La Cygne Community Park – this includes radios, TV’s, people and pets.
12. Only alcoholic beverages of 6% content are permissible in the park.
13. City Ordinance prohibits the **UNLAWFUL** discharge of firearms in the park. City Ordinance also prohibits the use of air guns, air rifles, bow and arrows, slingshots, BB guns or paint ball guns in the park.
14. Fires are permitted only in the fire rings located south of the camping slots (please be sure fires are fully extinguished).
15. For water or electrical emergencies call (913) 757-2144 and listen to the voicemail for on-call phone number.
16. For police or fire emergencies, please call 911.
17. The City of La Cygne and La Cygne City Council reserve the right to ask a patron to leave the premises if they are not following the rules and/or creating disruptive behavior in the La Cygne Community Park. Adverse contact with the La Cygne law enforcement, of any kind, will be grounds for removal from the park.
18. Rates and rules can change at anytime per resolutions put in place by the La Cygne City Council.
