**Boil Water Advisory Rescinded for the City of LaCygne and Linn County Rural Water District No. 3, Linn County**

**TOPEKA** – The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) has rescinded a boil water advisory for the City of LaCygne and Linn County Rural Water District No. 3 public water supply systems, located in Linn County. The advisory was issued because of high turbidity in the treated water at the LaCygne water treatment plant. High turbidity can lead to a loss of chlorine residual levels and may result in bacterial contamination.

Public water suppliers in Kansas take all measures necessary to notify customers quickly after a system failure or shutdown. Regardless of whether it's the supplier or KDHE that announces a boil water advisory, KDHE will issue the rescind order following testing at a certified laboratory.

Laboratory testing samples collected from the City of Lacygne and Linn County Rural Water District No. 3 indicate no evidence of bacteriological contamination and all other conditions that placed the system at risk of contamination are deemed by KDHE officials to be resolved.
