c] Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas Renewal January 2025. Group premium total for 2025 is \$11,503.18/month, individual premium increase averages are between 18-20% on health and 7.5% premium increase for Dental. There will be some adjustments to employees effective immediately. Total Health Insurance Budget for 2024 was \$273,800. BCBS does not include vision. CC Wade has not received VSP pricing for 2025 to date. Estimated monthly premium after adjustments \$11,174.25/month for a total of \$134,091/annually.
