Cemetery Memorial Day Info!

*Grave decorations: the decorations allowed on all graves are a memorial/headstone or grave marker, flowers in a permanent monument vase, monument wreaths and small American flags.

*Removal of decorations: the city may remove without notice all flowers and containers that interfere with mowing and maintenance. All flowers placed on Memorial Day may be removed after 15 days. However, the city shall not remove any flowers that are placed in permanent monument vases or on the monument that do not interfere with mowing and maintenance.

SUMMER TIPS

- It shall be lawful to discharge firecrackers and other fireworks, excluding bottle rockets, in the City of La Cygne on the Twenty-seventh day of June through fifth day of July between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. (midnight), per code section 6-204.
- Any person, persons or groups of persons may remain in a community park after the hour of 11:00 p.m. only after obtaining permission from the city clerk at the city hall, per code 11-207.
- Food Trucks or ice cream vendors should obtain a transient vendor license before selling their goods.
- Mow your grass before it is 12in tall per code section 7-602(e).
- Children under the age of 9 must be accompanied by an individual 16 years or older while at the La Cygne swimming pool.
- Curfew for any person under the age of 18 is 12:00a.m.-6:00a.m. per code 10-201(b).
- It shall be unlawful for any person to hereafter erect or cause to be erected within the city any building or structure of any kind or enlarge or add to the outside dimension thereof, or relocate any building or structure already erected within the city without a building permit being first obtained therefore from the city clerk, after approval by the city codes officer or his or her duly authorized assistant. The application for such permit shall be made and the permit obtained before work is commenced upon any building or structure or the foundation thereof, per code section 4-101.
- When burning brush, a person shall remain at the site until burning is complete per code section 7-408. Call the county and notify them of any burning.
- For ATV, UTV, golf cart rules and regulation refer to codes chapter 13.

2023 Fire Station Project

After 27 years of commitment from prior governing bodies and fire chiefs, the City is proud to announce the La Cygne Fire station will be constructed in 2023.

The city diligently researched lots, building styles, pursued grants and placed funds in a reserve account to prepare for the projected project cost. The goal was to provide storage for current equipment and future growth but operate and maintain within the current budget funding for the Fire Department - THAT GOAL WAS MET!

Taxes did not have to be modified to accomplish this project

- \$272,200 Fire Dept reserves
- \$210,000 PBC Revenue Bonds
- \$170,769 ARPA Grant Award
- \$208,000 Capital Improv Reserve
- \$100,000 FOG Trust Fund Grant Award
