Waste Management 2024 Rate Changes

The rates for residential trash service will increase as follows:

- Curb side/ no tote (personal container) will no longer be available.
- One (1) Tote price \$21.57
- Two (2) Tote price \$31.57
- ** Effective as of January 1, 2024 a refundable deposit of \$75 will be required for NEW applications for trash service.

Deceased Account Holder

Should the holder of a utility account die or leave permanently, the person still residing therein shall establish service under their name within 30 days of the triggering event.

Failure to transfer the utility account to the current resident, or to that person responsible for paying the utility bill within 30 days will result in disconnection of the utilities.

Please call the City of La Cygne for complete details and to see if a new deposit is required.

Returned Payments

- 1. All returned payments shall be paid in cash within 7-days of notice of the return of payment.
- 2. Unpaid accounts after the 7-day period shall be disconnected. Disconnected Utility Accounts must be paid in full including all fees to be reinstated.
- 3. A Utility account shall be placed on a cashonly-basis after the second occurrence of returned payment within a 12-month period.
- 4. Unpaid accounts due to return of payment which are not paid within 30-days shall be terminated.

Spring Time Reminders



In Preparation for mowing season, the city will be removing all loose flowers and decorations from Oak Lawn Cemetery starting on Monday, March 18.

Flowers and decorations that are in permanent containers on the stones will not be removed. We request that you remove any decorations you wish to keep prior to Monday, March 18. Thank you, for your help with this!

Per La Cygne City Code it is unlawful to have grass taller than 12 inches. It is unlawful to deposit yard waste in or upon any public right-of-way, street, alley, water or grounds in the City. Yard waste, such as; tree limbs, leaves, grass and/or weeds may be burned between sunrise and sunset. Those are the only items permissible to be burned in the City of La Cygne. Before doing any burning you need to call Linn County at 913.795.2665 to check to see if there is an active burn ban and to indicate the time of your burn. You must stay with your burn for the entirety of the burn, do not leave it unattended. Ouestions? Call Devin Canada at 913.757.2144
